This past month was "Tsagaan Sar". It is a time when people visit their family and friends over a 5 day period. They wear their traditional clothing called a "deel" and eat traditional food called "buuz". We had the privilege to visit in 5 homes. We ate many "buuz". I have attached pictures of our family in our "deels". We also tried camel milk. The weather has now began to warm up. It has warmed up enough that we have seen snow a couple times. As the weather warms people will begin to venture out more. Pray with us that God's people will remain faithful as the Devil will try to distract them during the warmer months to come.

This third term I am teaching 8th grade students for my English classes. Also, I am working with students from other schools that do not have a native English speaker every other week at New Era. For four weeks I have been working with another school, Mongol Aspirations to help prepare their students for an upcoming verbal English test that I will also be administering. Please pray I will have a Godly influence on the students and staff.

Our Mongolian language is still improving. We are able to hold very basic conversations. We will need to continue to study the language for a couple more years before we will be able to preach or teach in the Mongolian Language. Please pray God would: open our mind for understanding and remembering words, our ears for hearing the distinctions in language, and our mouths to form the correct sounds.

We are planning to come back to the U.S. this summer. Before that our mission board, BIMI, is planning a connect trip on May 15-28 to Hong Kong & Mongolia. The second semester of our Bible training classes are in full swing. We have 6 students this semester. This semester courses include: Soul – Winning/Discipleship, Introduction to Computer, New Testament Survey 2, Mongolian Composition, and Introduction to English. Please pray as we continue to train Mongolians for future ministry and for our plan to seek registration for the Bible College.

The college and career ministry is going strong. We had 18 attend our "Love for God" banquet. We have had a great time studying about "Abiding in Christ" on Sundays during our Sunday School time. Please pray as we teach these young people how to continue to grow their relationship with Christ.

Please pray for the Jason Ritchie family as they are in states for furlough. They will be returning mid – April. I have enjoyed preaching in our English and Mongolian (with a translator) services. Please pray for God's help for us to be effective in Reaching Mongolia for Christ.
