Sermon Notes



April 13, 2025

"Let's Really, Really, Really, Really Love One Another (Since God Really, Really, Really, Really Loves Us)" 1 John 4:7-12

Holy Week

Follow Jesus during His final week leading to the cross.

Sunday, April 13: Jesus triumphantly enters the city of Jerusalem, mounted humbly on a donkey in keeping with prophetic messianic prediction. He later predicts his impending death and teaches at the Temple. *Read Matthew 21:1-17*

Monday, April 14: Jesus curses a fig tree, symbolizing spiritually barren Israel, and cleanses the Jerusalem Temple, possibly for the second time. He acts as the one who is going to restore proper worship as the replacement and fulfillment of the Temple. *Read Matthew 21: 18-27*

Tuesday, April 15: Jesus continues to teach on the Temple grounds and engages in various controversies with the Jewish leaders. He also predicts the future preceding his return. *Read Matthew 22:1-14*

Wednesday, April 16: Little is known about Jesus' whereabouts at the midpoint of the week. The Gospel narratives only mention the unfolding plot by the Jewish authorities against Jesus. But this is only the quiet before the storm that is brewing and that will shortly turn into a hurricane. Read Matthew 22:15-22 & Matthew 26:3-5 & Matthew 26: 14-16

Thursday, April 17: Jesus and his followers engage in preparations for celebrating the Jewish Passover, Jesus' Last Supper at which he institutes a new covenant. Judas the Betrayer leaves the Upper Room. Jesus agonizes over his impending death in the Garden of Gethsemane. Peter denies Jesus three times, in keeping with Jesus' earlier prediction. *Read Matthew 26:17-56 & Matthew 26:69-75*

Friday, April 18: Jesus is betrayed and arrested. He is subjected to trials before the Jewish and Roman authorities. Pontius Pilate, the Roman governor, pronounces a "guilty verdict" against his better judgment. Jesus is crucified. *Read Matthew 27:11-61*

Saturday, April 19: The Jewish Sabbath extends from Friday sundown to Saturday sundown. Nothing is known about the whereabouts of the disciples. Most likely, they went into hiding for fear of the Jewish authorities. The authorities ask Pilate for permission to secure Jesus' tomb. *Read Matthew 27:62-66*

Sunday, April 20: When several female disciples of Jesus, including Mary Magdalene, approach his tomb, they find it empty. Later, Jesus appears to Mary, as well as ten of the apostles, and several others. This is the Lord's Day, Resurrection Sunday! *John 20: 1-31*

Additional Reading: It's enriching to read the Passover, Crucifixion, and Resurrection recounts in all four Gospels. Each Gospel fills in different details of that Holy weekend, and when read all together, the Story is riveting!
