Sometimes you see the light bulb turn on in someone's brain. We're going through the Kingdom History in Youth Sunday School right now and I saw one of our Freshmen's eyes light up after he processed the emphatic statement I had just made, "I think you're more likely to have a Seal Team of angels than one guardian."

¹⁵ When the servant of the man of God rose early in the morning and went out, behold, an army with horses and chariots was all around the city. And the servant said, "Alas, my master! What shall we do?" ¹⁶ He said, "Do not be afraid, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them." ¹⁷ Then Elisha prayed and said, "O Lord, please open his eyes that he may see." So the Lord opened the eyes of the young man, and he saw, and behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha.

2 Kings 6

The most significant points in these verses are that there is an unseen spiritual world all around us and that God is watching over us. We are not alone or abandoned. Less important, but perhaps just as eye opening, is the thought that our angelic security detail seems to be plural and not singular.

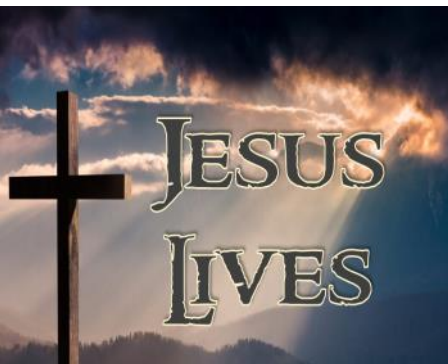
Psalm 91:11 mentions angels watching over us.

Matthew 26:53 records Jesus declaring 12 legions of angels are at His disposal.

However, don't get distracted by Angels, here. This spiritual reality should direct us toward God and not His creation, something we see angels point out as well (Rev 19:1-10, 22:8,9).

Rather, we are called to remember we live in more than just a physical world and to gear up for battle each day (Ephesians 6), yet for increased confidence, know that God has assigned angelic warriors to walk with you.
