

Faith

Over the past several weeks I have been reading and thinking about faith as presented in Scriptures. It is a very rewarding process. I recommend it to you. Just search for words like faith. I also stumbled(?) on a connection between faith and hope and waiting. They are really quite similar. To get you started, let me suggest a few verses.

First, start with the Biblical definition of faith found in Hebrews 1:1, "Faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen." Faith has to do with things you can't see with your physical eyes.

Then I noticed in Romans 8:23-25, "And not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the first-fruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies. For in this hope we were saved. Now hope that is seen is not hope, for who hopes for what he sees? But if we hope for what we do not see we wait for it with patience." Note the similar concept regarding things you can't see. It seems the Biblical kind of faith, hope and waiting are very similar.

All of these have delayed gratification, they don't involve immediate reward. As a result, they are difficult and feel painful to us. So I noticed some verses that seem to help us understand some of the why of this. Hebrews 11: 6 tells us that without faith it is impossible to please God – faith is a way to please God. Also note I Peter 1:7, which says that "the tested genuineness of your faith – more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire - may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ. Though you have not seen him, you love him. Though you do not now see him you believe in him and rejoice with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory, obtaining the outcome of our faith, the salvation of your souls." This is a reason to endure even when waiting and faith is difficult.

So think on these things to encourage your faith this week.
