Wedding Policies & Procedures

Engagement Commitments

We believe that marriage is a holy and sacred gift from God, so it is our intent that couples approach marriage according to biblical standards and in a way that is pleasing to God.

Beliefs:

God has intended Christians to only marry Christians, so we require that both the bride and groom confirm commitment to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.

Purity:

The sexual relationship has been designed and intended for marriage, so we ask that you agree to abstain from any sexual relationship until after the wedding. Furthermore, a living arrangement that includes cohabitation prior to the wedding is a compromise of Christian guidelines, so we require that you agree to separate living arrangements until after the wedding.

Faithfulness:

The church is God's primary tool for building strong marriages, so we ask that you find a place to serve within the church and pursue a lifestyle of faithfulness to your church family.

Purpose:

We believe that marriage is a God-ordained and life-long commitment between a man and a woman. We believe that it should be entered into only after careful consideration has been made of a couple's mutual love and compatibility. A healthy marriage requires a healthy foundation. At CenterPoint, we're passionate about healthy marriages that are centered on Jesus, bring glory to God, and are a lifelong friendship that grow every year.

Partnership:

Partnership is not required to have a wedding at CenterPoint Church. However, because of the investment of our partners, we offer them preferred scheduling.

Pre-Marriage Counseling:

All couples getting married at CenterPoint Church are required to fulfill the following preparation steps:

1. Meet with the pastor who is marrying you for a one-hour "get acquainted" session. This meeting should take place as soon as possible after both of you have completed your pre-marriage questionnaire.
2. Complete *Preparing for Marriage* General editor Dennis Rainey book (6-8 sessions) prior to wedding
