Celebrating the Saints: Oswald Chambers (24 July 1874 – 15 November 1917) was an early twentieth century Scottish Baptist evangelist and teacher, best known for the devotional *My Utmost for His Highest*. In 1911 Chambers founded and was principal of the Bible Training College in London where they accommodated not only students of every age, education, and class but also anyone in need, believing they ought to "give to everyone who asks." No one was ever turned away from the door and whatever the person asked for, whether money, a winter overcoat, or a meal, was given.
