The undersigned further hereby agrees to hold harmless and indemnify said church, its pastors, ministers, officers, employees and disciples from any liability, claims or demands for personal injury, sickness or death, as well as property damage and expenses of any nature whatsoever which may be incurred by the participant that occurs while said person is participating in the above time period.

The undersigned further consents to the administration of first-aid and/or doctor's care, or any other form of medical treatment necessitated by illness or injury that may require the same. In the event of the necessity of such care or treatment, the undersigned agrees to hold harmless said church.

HAPPY CAMPER RULES

I also agree to follow the rules of Shiloh Community Church Campground:

1. The function must be sponsored by a church member or ok'd by the campground committee.
2. The function must be non-profit, non-political.
3. The procedure and activities that take place, in no way conflict with the purpose of Shiloh Community Church or compromise good Christian conduct and witness.
4. The grounds used must be left just as they were found.
5. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are to be brought onto any part of the campgrounds.
6. No church owned property should be taken from the premises without proper authorization.
7. In accordance with the State of Michigan, no camper should allow sewage or grey water to escape their unit and run on the ground.
8. It is against the law to create a breach of the peace, disturb or annoy others with violent, abusive, loud, boisterous, vulgar, lewd, wanton, obscene or otherwise disorderly conduct.
9. Do not leave garbage or trash in the fire pit or on the campsite.
10. Please help us keep the restrooms clean.
11. If you have pets camping with you, keep them on a leash and do not leave them unattended. Please remember to clean up after your pet.
