

God inspired Al Hamilton in the mid-1970's with a passion and a vision to mobilize more of God's people for the task of translating Scripture into every language. He and other members of the Christian Churches began to recruit missionaries from Restoration Movement churches to translate the Bible. From this vision, Pioneer Bible Translators was born in 1976.

Pioneer Bible Translators bridges the gap between the church and the Bibleless peoples around the world. Their team is composed of Bible translators, literacy evangelists, church planters and a variety of support personnel working to see transformed lives through God's Word in every language. They are serving 102.5 million people in 108 language projects in 28 countries.

Pioneer Bible Translators exists to disciple the Bibleless, mobilizing God's people to provide enduring access to God's Word. Their vision is to see transformed lives through God's Word in every language. The work is not finished until there are networks of churches using Scripture to grow, mature and multiply in every language group on Earth. Prayer is their strategy.

PCOC supports a family working with Pioneer Bible Translators. They recently were a part of finishing the translation of the book of Luke for a people group that didn't have it. A part of history was made! Some of their prayer needs are, discernment in printing and distributing the book of Luke among the people, to lead the right number of people to join them in a financial partnership, travel mercies as they plan and prepare to return to Southeast Asia this month and the transitions their family will need to make, such as school, and that God will lead people from this group to engage fully with His Word and be deeply impacted by it and experience transformation in Christ alone.
