**DCS Financial Policy – Summary**

1. Tuition and fees cover the basic expenses of education and does not include special services or projects.
2. FACTS Tuition Management sets monthly tuition date.
3. Fees are assessed for late payments and NSF checks.
4. Students may not be permitted to attend classes if an account becomes delinquent.
5. A discount will be considered for pastoral families who are in full-time ministry.
6. A student who withdraws will be charged tuition and any incurred fees through the day of withdrawal.
7. Families should expect annual tuition increases.

The DuBois Christian Schools' Committee and Administration urge parents to recognize their scriptural responsibility (Deuteronomy 6:1-9, Psalm 78:5, 6, Proverbs 22:6) to provide their children with a Christian education, and to understand that the primary responsibility for this task rests with the parents (Ephesians 6:4). DCS was founded, and continues to operate upon biblical values, and the desire and commitment for Bible-believing Christian parents to enroll their children in an intentionally Christian environment. DCS will consider admission for students from any family who, despite their religious background or beliefs, is willing to support the DCS's philosophy of Christian education, student conduct requirements, Parent's Pledge, and who is willing to allow their children to be educated and influenced in an intentionally Christian environment. Continued enrollment at DCS is contingent upon this same understanding and support.

DuBois Christian Schools stands firmly upon the historical truth claims and moral foundations of Christianity. This includes, but is not limited to, the biblical definition of marriage as a covenant relationship between a man and a woman, the attendant boundaries of sexuality and moral conduct, and the clear biblical teaching that gender is both sacred and established by God's design. Parents, or the legal guardians, who choose to enroll their children at DCS are agreeing to support these and other basic biblical values derived from historical Christianity, and the relevant Christian positions embraced by First Baptist Church of DuBois, under whose authority this school rests. Parents understand and agree that DCS will teach these principles and biblical values.

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## **Statement of Faith**

We believe the Bible to be inerrant, verbally inspired and produced by the Holy Spirit. We believe the Bible to be the only rule of faith and practice.

We believe there is only one living and true God and there are three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – equal in every divine perfection, essence and power.
