RESPONDING TO THE GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN

The recent shutdown has disrupted SNAP benefits and strained local food programs. Our church is responding with:

- \$3,220 to the Lancaster Food Hub (Missions Team)
- \$1,500 for food boxes through LUMINA (Outreach Team)
- \$2,438 to our Social Service Fund (Outreach Team)
- A Christmas food drive for Lancaster Food Hub (Youth & Outreach)
- Nonprofits like Anchor Lancaster are now paying \$1,000 a week for food once provided free. This year's Christmas Eve offering will go entirely to Anchor Lancaster.
