Brief History of the Family Activity Center of Tullahoma FUMC

One of the most widely used facilities at First United Methodist Church of Tullahoma is the Family Activity Center (FAC) Building located behind the main church building.

In 1984, church officials and other members of the congregation gathered for a groundbreaking ceremony for the FAC building. After the FAC Building was completed, it included a gymnasium, a kitchen, a small dining room, and a youth room upstairs.

In 1994, the FAC building was enlarged on the right side of the building. It expanded the small dining room for people to use on Wednesday night dinners as well as other social gatherings. In addition to the expansion of the dining room, the new addition included four Sunday School rooms and two restrooms. During that same year, a children's playground was developed on the outside lawn in front of the new addition to the FAC Building.
