

## **Connectional Corner-June 2023**

This will be the final edition of the Connectional Corner (CC) as Tullahoma First Methodist Church is no longer in a connectional relationship with a Methodist denomination. The original intent of the Connectional Corner was to prepare this congregation for General Conference 2020, where there were 6 proposed legislative bills to split the UMC. The first issue of the Connectional Corner was published January 2020 with the thought there would be 5 editions before the May 2020 General Conference. Thirty-five CC issues later, there still has been no GC 2020 but the UMC has split. On June 1, 2023, Tullahoma First Methodist Church charts a new beginning as an independent Methodist congregation.

On Monday, May 22, 2023, a specially called meeting of the Tennessee-Western Kentucky (TWK) Annual Conference was held via Zoom for one purpose – to allow those congregations wishing to leave the UMC to depart. Voting members of the Annual Conferences' 840 churches approved the requests from 162 churches to disaffiliate from the UMC. This represents just under 20% of the TWK congregations. Tullahoma First was one of the 162 congregations approved to depart from the UMC. All the leaving churches met the procedures of paragraph 2553 in the Book of Discipline to be included in this special session. Another special session will be held on November 13, 2023, to approve other congregations who did not meet the deadline for this special session. Paragraph 2553 expires at the end of this year, with no more congregations able to depart the UMC after November 13<sup>th</sup> under paragraph 2553.

At the February Church Council meeting, a program was approved to guide our congregation through the disaffiliation and beyond. (See Feb. 2023 CC.) In the four months since, the Steering Committee has completed all requirements for disaffiliation allowing us to depart the UMC at the May specially called Annual Conference. The Educational Task Force is hard at work laying the groundwork to educate the congregation whether to remain independent or align with another Wesleyan denomination. The Polity Task Force has completed the Bylaws which were approved at the April Church Council meeting, and are nearing completing of a Doctrine. At the May Council meeting, a Continuing Resolution was passed keeping our congregation under the rules of the 2016 UMC Book of Discipline until December 31, 2023, which gives the Polity Task Force time to complete both the Doctrine and Discipline of TFMC. Hopefully you have already seen and used the excellent work of the Spiritual Enrichment Task Force. This Task Force is helping us maintain Christ's presence in our lives as TFMC moves forward.

Members of Tullahoma First Methodist Church – the future of this congregation requires your participation. Above all, continue to pray for our congregation. Everyone in the congregation is invited to attend Church Council meetings and participate in discussions, however, only Council members may cast votes. The next Church Council meeting is on June 14<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 in Davidson Hall. The future of Tullahoma First Methodist Church is in your hands.
