### **Youth Choir**

to be better worshipers for the rest of their lives, by learning to use their voices, memorize theologically rich songs, and enjoy the community element of music-making.

From the festive Christmas service with choirs and special instruments, to the joy of Easter Sunrise Service in historic Old Town Alexandria with the Praise Team leading worship, APC believes that music is a powerful tool through which we can share the Gospel with our city. Each week, music ushers us into God's presence from the very start of our service, with an 8:50 musical prelude, preparing the congregation to "come before him with joyful songs" as we worship Him together.

At APC we are passionate about corporate worship, believing that God meets His people when they gather to praise Him. Since music is a central activity to coming into God's presence, we seek to honor Him through an array of musical ensembles. Our 8:50 service at our Russell Road Campus includes the APC Choirs (Adult and Youth), the Praise Team, and instrumental music. At our 11am service at the Braddock Road Campus, the Praise Team is the primary worship ensemble. The following is a description of each musical group.
