YOUR SINS ARE FORGIVEN

I am writing to you, little children, because your sins are forgiven for His name's sake.

1 John 2:12

When you read the little letter of 1 John, it is hard to miss how much the apostle John cares about those to whom he is writing. He refers to them as "my little children" (2:1), "little children" (2:12, 28; 3:7, 18; 4:4; 5:21), "children" (2:13, 18), and "beloved" (2:7; 3:2, 21; 4:1, 7, 11). Through these terms of endearment, John draws his readers into his heart, giving them a reason to listen to him and put into practice what he says. Like a tender father, John displays his love to give us confidence and assurance in our walk of faith.

With such love for those who read his letter, we might think John would avoid difficult or uncomfortable topics. Yet, John repeatedly deals with sin in his letter to his little children. He warns us against saying we have no sin (1:8, 10), and he is writing so we may not sin (2:1). He knows we will sin (1:9, 2:1), but he also reassures us that Christ has dealt with our sin (1:7, 9; 2:2). All of this, and we have only scratched the surface of the first two chapters!

When we get to 1 John 2:12, John again mentions sin, but he does so to remind us of gospel realities that have impacted our lives. We must not forget the truth that our sins are forgiven. The forgiveness we possess through Jesus Christ is a source of encouragement and brings peace to our lives. It is as if John says to us, "Rest assured, your sins are forgiven." The way John has written this is also helpful. He puts "forgiven" in the perfect passive voice (a rare combination in New Testament Greek) to stress we took no part in securing our forgiveness. Christ did everything necessary to forgive us of our sins, and we did nothing to earn His forgiveness. It is Jesus' blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins (Matt. 26:28). The only way the forgiveness of our sins is possible is through Christ's death on the cross.

In Christ, we enjoy the gospel reality of knowing our sins are forgiven, which leads to gospel transformation in our lives. It frees us to live for Him, love Him, and do God's will (2:17). At the same time, let us not overlook the last four words of our verse, "for His name's sake." John gives the reason why our sins are forgiven, to glorify Christ. We are

not forgiven for our name's sake but for His. Our forgiveness does not make much of us but exalts Christ's name and work. In our forgiven state, and as gospel transformation takes place in our lives, we are living testimonies to the glory of our Savior. Maybe that's why we frequently need to hear, "Your sins are forgiven." Not only do we receive assurance in our faith, but Christ is also continually magnified for His saving work in our lives. May He be glorified all the more as we enjoy the gospel reality of our forgiveness.
