

Pay Attention

"And we have the prophetic word more fully confirmed, to which you will do well to pay attention as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts"

2 Peter 1:19

The beginning of a new year marks new resolutions or, perhaps, a clean slate. How are we going to start this new year? What are we going to give ourselves to? Better habits? Healthier eating? More consistent exercise? We often spend time thinking about what needs to change in our lives.

In 2 Peter 1:19, we are not first told what needs to change, but it highlights what we already possess. We have the prophetic Word. There is something good already in our lives, and the good Word does not change; it does not need to change. The prophetic Word is the Word of God, sure, reliable, trustworthy, and true. We have been given a gift by God in His prophetic Word because this Word is nothing less than a revelation of Himself to us.

God revealed Himself to us in His Word, fully confirmed in Jesus Christ. On the road to Emmaus, Jesus instructed and corrected two of His disciples when He said, "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?" And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself" (Luke 24:25-27). The Eternal Word has fully confirmed the prophetic, written Word.

What are we to do with this fully confirmed Word that we possess? We are to pay attention to it. In reading, meditating, singing, and praying, we feast on the Word by intently and purposefully listening to what it says. Paying attention to it is not acknowledging it exists or having intellectual knowledge about it. Wives rightly want their husbands to pay attention to them, but that involves more than a head nod recognizing they are a living human being. In learning and studying all they can about their wives, husbands are to act and speak in complete love, devotion, care, and

faithfulness toward them. Pay attention to the Word because it is a lamp shining in a dark place. "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path" (Psalm 119:105). We need the light to guide us through this year and throughout our lives as we look forward to the final day.

The day dawning and the morning star rising refers to the second coming of Christ. When that happens, not only will the creation be forever changed, but the hearts of believers will be forever purified and sanctified. 2 Peter 2:19 provides a good balance for us as we begin a new year. We pay attention to the fully confirmed, prophetic Word and look forward to the day Jesus returns in His glory. He will drive all the darkness away and finally make everything right. Let us go into a new year with all our hope in Him.

The book of the month will be available at the desk as well as other highlighted resources.


Some of our sign-ups will also be located at the desk for your convenience from now on.
