

## Repent & Return

"But I have this against you, that you have abandoned the love you had at first. Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent, and do the works you did at first. If not, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent."

Revelation 2:4-5

As we go through the Book of Revelation on Wednesday evenings, we are currently studying the seven letters to the seven churches in chapters 2 and 3. These are letters written by the glorious Christ to His beloved church, with truths that apply to these historical churches and the church throughout the ages. We must listen to these letters to be instructed, encouraged, exhorted, and corrected by them. They come to us with the weight of Christ's authority as the head of His church. "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches" (Revelation 2:7, 11, 17, 29; 3:6, 13, 22).

Five of the seven churches receive correction. Both the first church (Ephesus) and the last church (Laodicea) are in grave spiritual danger. Ephesus, in particular, has abandoned the love they had at first. As a community of Christ, they have left their love for Christ. Their zeal and passion for Him have become frigid and cold. Jesus calls upon them to remember from where they have fallen, repent, and do the works they did at the first. Here is the blueprint for their course correction. All is not lost, yet. There is still an opportunity for them to recognize their sin, turn from their sin, and return to the Lord through doing those works they did when their love for Him was strong. If they do not do this, they face judgment.

Jesus warns the Ephesian church of the judgment they face when He says, "If not, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent." Christ will not come to them with blessing but restitution for the grievous sin they committed against Him. By removing their lampstand, He would remove their witness from the world. They would no longer be considered a true church. Once a pillar and buttress of the truth, those who guarded the gospel of Jesus Christ would be no more. But this is only part of the judgment.

In Revelation 1:13 and 2:1, we read that Jesus is the One in the midst of the lampstands and is ceaselessly walking among them. It is supposed to be a comforting reminder to the church of Christ's constant presence with His church

and His compassionate care for them. For the church in Ephesus, the removal of their lampstand meant the removal of the presence of Christ. There would be no comfort for them because Christ would not be in their midst. What a horrifying thought such a warning would be to any true church. But how even more horrifying when the "church" does not even notice the presence of Christ is absent from among them? The Ephesian church could have continued in their toil, patient endurance, and discernment of false apostles (Rev. 2:2), thinking they were faithful. All the while, their unrepentant, cold, hard, loveless hearts meant that Christ was no longer present with them.

The call for the church to repent still stands. Let us make sure that we have not abandoned the love we had at first. May we continually go back to the works we did at first when our love for the Lord was strong and our passion to make Him known burned hot, for His presence in our midst must never be missed.




## **Men's Ministry**







