

God's Attention

One of my favorite lines from a popular comedy show is "You couldn't handle my undivided attention." It's delivered from a character who is intense and rather difficult to get along with. Part of the humor of this line is that the audience finds themselves wholeheartedly agreeing. It would not be pleasant to have his undivided attention! This fictional scenario shouldn't be taken seriously because no human could ever devote their attention perfectly, not even to one person. There are innumerable distractions that demand at least a portion of our attention. We so often lose focus. God, in his infinite perfection, does not. In his preface to George Swinnock's *The Blessed and Boundless God* (a book we'll continue to consider), J. Stephen Yuille says that the boundless God "is undivided, meaning His every thought and every action involve the whole of Him. He simultaneously gives total and undivided attention to everything and everyone." God's attention is never distracted, lost, or divided. It is certainly intense, but unlike the character above, God's attention is perfect and lovingly providential.

In reference to God's attention, I want to consider two doctrines that Swinnock addresses in his book. The first is the simplicity of God. When we refer to God as simple, we don't mean the more modern definition from Oxford: "easily understood or done; presenting no difficulty." We mean an older understanding: "Single; consisting of one thing; uncompounded;

unmingled; uncombined with any thing else" (from Webster's 1828). God is simple in his composition. There are no parts to God. As Swinnock writes, "God is a most simple, unmixed, and indivisible essence. He is incapable of the least composition and, therefore, of the least division. He is most pure – without parts, members or qualities." As this applies to his attention, we can understand that it can't be divided. God is fully aware, fully present, and fully active everywhere. He, at once, knows all the birds that fall and the number of hairs on every head (Matt. 10:29-30).

The second doctrine I want us to consider is God's providence. We know from Heb. 1:3 that Christ "upholds the universe by the word of his power" and from Col. 1:17 that "he is before all things, and in him all things hold together." In response to the question of how God upholds all things, Swinnock explains that God himself is the foundation upon which they stand, from which they derive their motion, and by which they hold together so that it is "impossible for the creation (or any part of it) to exist even for a moment if God were to deny His concurrence to it." In relation to God's attention, we know that if God were to remove his attention from us, then we would cease to exist. God's providential attention is necessary for life because he is the one who sustains it. The deist belief in God as a watchmaker who set the world in motion and left it to run on its own is erroneous and unbiblical. God cares for his creation with a kind and loving attention, not abandoning it to its own destruction.

Take comfort, brothers and sisters, in the knowledge that God's attention is undividedly whole, providentially caring, and completely perfect. He loves his children and will pay attention to their welfare. Be reminded of Psalm 8 which reveals God's careful, loving attention toward us.

When I look at your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place,
 what is man that you are mindful of him,

and the son of man that you care for him?
