We are now working on containers that will go to Guatemala, Honduras, and Mexico, which will take about most of the year. We will have half of the print shop working on this project, and the other half working on the needs that will be coming in. When we started off knowing we knew it would be a very high dollar project, and \$50,000.00 is a lot of money to us, but this work will cost over \$150,000.00. The pastor took a deep breath, and by faith gave the workers the green light to put their hands to the plow, and watch how God will provide, and provide He did!! Within three weeks we had over \$120,000.00, and now we have gotten the rest. We had to have 26,000 Spanish Bibles and they have been purchased, and should be coming in the last of this month. This is not the only work that is going, but it sure has our hearts rejoicing.

*Upgrading Presses and Collating Machines:* We bought used machines, but they are new to us. The collators sure have improved the amount of work that is being done, and made the workers very happy because they won't break down as much. We have ordered a very good color press that will be coming in sometimes next week. The print shop sure will look different. The best part of this story is that it is all paid for.

Personal Note: I just knew that last year would find me slowing down some, (I though that in 22; it didn't happen then either) but God had another plan and I like what He wants me to do. Most of the miles found me going by myself, because my wife hasn't been doing well. We were in 11 different states, and seeing God add new Churches that are supporting the work. Thank you for praying for safety on the roads, I think my ministering angels will be happy when I come off the road.

A Great Need: Our workers have been faithful, but the print shop director is down with a major back problem, and the lady that is the part time worker is also having back problems. We don't know what is needed, but God does. So pray that He will bless us by filling this need.
