



## H2O INTERNSHIP

Now is YOUR chance to serve alongside H2O in a new church plant, being apart of a team and play a bigger role in all that God is doing on the campus of WSU.

### WHAT IS AN H2O INTERNSHIP ALL ABOUT?

An H2O internship is a 3-to-12 month opportunity designed to give you a chance to further develop your leadership abilities and to give you a taste of vocational ministry. While we H2O Wright State is a new church plant, serving, mentoring, and ministering alongside the H2O plant team and staff, our hope is for you to continue to grow as a fully devoted follower of Christ. We want your internship with H2O to be the best possible.

Furthermore, we are all about multiplication at H2O. Our desire is that even while you are learning a skill, you are seeking to teach others about it and intentionally building into other students.

### CAN IT BE A PAID INTERNSHIP?

Yes! The route that many students use to ensure their needs will be met during their internship is to raise support. This involves asking people in your life and/or people that you have networked with for both spiritual and financial support—so that you can do the ministry God has called you to unhindered.

But not to worry! H2O will offer informational training courses to help you raise your support and the H2O staff are always available for assistance. Raising support also provides a jumpstart for anyone who desires to pursue full-time ministry as an occupation.

You may also consider an un-paid internship. You will want to consider your living arrangements, expenses, and financial needs before choosing this option. College credit is often available with an H2O internship.

### WHAT WILL I BE DOING?

While all interns will take part in H2O Sundays, Life Groups, and special events, each intern will be given a specific job description based on our H2O Teams. These teams include: First Impressions, Ambiance, Pre-Service Prayer, Worship, Production, Media, Video, Connecting, International, Events, Design/Creative Arts, Operations (Finance & Administration), Pastoral Assistant, H2O Kids Splash, and Women's

Leadership Catalyst. Interns will work with a manager to formulate specific job roles that serve the needs of the church and utilize individual gifts and talents. Visit our website under the "Get Involved" tab for more information about each team and for specific needs and job descriptions.

### WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

As an H2O Intern, we expect you to:

- Be able to serve a minimum of 10hrs a week for H2O
- Encouraged to do the Well program
- Must have served faithfully in church for 1 year prior to application
- Maintain good standing with Wright State University (if you are a student)
- Live a life in accordance with your identity in Christ
- Agree with H2O's Mission and Doctrinal Statement
- Submit to pastoral authority and to the authority of your manager
- Faithful to attend all management times
- Be able to complete work without direct supervision
- Active attendance and participation with H2O Sundays, Groups, scheduled events, and to perform assigned job roles
