



Sunday School Opportunities Fall 2016

The Adult Commons Class will meet in room 212. Ed Langham and Steve Dunn will lead a series titled "What Do We Believe?", which will take an in depth look into the Westminster Confession and the larger and shorter Catechisms. This is an opportunity to study the Evangelical Presbyterian faith more deeply and focus more deeply on what it is that we believe.

Connections, a life application class, will study the book of Mark. The class format includes conversation and discussion facilitated by several different leaders in the Common Ground coffeeshop.

The Faith Alive Class meets in Room 207 and is led by Bettye Jo Wilson. The class is a Bible-centered study which will include topics such as the power of the Holy Spirit, Jesus in Every Book of the Bible, How to Share Our Faith, and the Sovereignty of God.

The Men's Class meets in the Scout Hut. This Bible-centered class draws lessons from the words of Jesus.

The Youth Sunday School Class meets in The Shop and is led by Sean Coleman and Ryan Cobb. Their study is drawn from "The Jesus I Never Knew" by Phillip Yancey.

The **Sunday School** Curriculum is *Grow, Proclaim, Serve!* This curriculum incorporates Bible stories, activities, crafts, media, and games into a full faith experience for children. It teaches children skills to unlock the Bible message and helps them grow in their faith. It is taught by a rotating group of church members.

There is a church nursery located in the childcare wing of our church for infants through age three in rooms 133 and 136.
