1. Read John 14:25-26. What 3 names/descriptions are used for the Holy Spirit? What does each one tell us about who he is and what he does?
2. Compare John 16:12-15. Why do these verses help give comfort to the disciples for the time after Jesus leaves?
3. How does this promise that Jesus gives cause confidence in the sufficiency of Scripture?
4. If, by implication, these verses also mean that we can believe **EVERY** word given to us is meant to be from Jesus and that it's meant to **Progressively** reveal Jesus' ministry...if those are true, what are some ways that you can express that trust and confidence in the Scriptures?
5. How might the above view of Scripture affect how you to minister the word to others?
