

100 Days of Prayer Week 12

Prayers for our Nation - Day 6 (17 days until the election)

1 Timothy 2:1-4 NKJV

Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, 2 for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. 3 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, 4 who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Today let us pray for the judicial branch of our government. Their job is to interpret the laws and give a judgment based on evidence, testimony, and the written law. It starts with our local county judges and then moves all the way up to our Supreme Court. Therefore, we need godly and God-fearing judges in our nation. They must be impartial and unbiased. Help them to love justice and mercy when deciding their cases. Give them a spirit of knowledge and wisdom from on high. Increase their understanding and revelation of the laws and statutes in our land. We pray that those who are not born again will have an encounter with Jesus by the Holy Spirit and becoming believers in Christ. We pray that they would all be led by the Spirit of truth. We pray for every clerk and paralegal, bailiff, and staff person in our courts that they would be blessed with discernment and grace. Give Chief Justice Roberts your blessing today, we ask that his heart would be turned to you in a greater measure and that he would lead with integrity and character. We ask that protect all those who serve in this branch of government. We ask all this in the mighty name of Jesus. AMEN!
