Praying Prayers of Intercession- Day 2

1 Timothy 2:1-2

Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, 2 for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence.

Today let us intercede for the nation. Our nation is at a turning point. We need Father God to give us wisdom and guidance in our election process, August 18th and November 3rd. The scriptures tell us in Psalms 33:12 "12 Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD:..." NKJV
