Baby boomers, generation z, millennials and the list goes on. We assign these titles to generations of people so that we can better understand why people are the way they are. But what title would you give a generation who seek God? In Psalm 24 David answers this question and calls them “blessed”.

He writes, “One who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not lift up their soul to an idol or swear by what is false. They will receive blessing from the Lord. Such is a generation of those who seek him.”¹

David envisions a generation of people who are defined by one thing alone; they seek God. They seek God for their identity. They seek God for their belonging. They seek God for their purpose. They seek God for everything. And the natural outcome is that they are a blessed generation. Is there an area of your life that you haven’t really been seeking God? If so, consider bringing it before Him today. ¹Psalm 24:4-5a, 6
