**Key Verse:** Romans 1:15 *I am eager to preach the gospel...*

Praise and thank the Lord for the salvation He has given us, by grace through faith (Ephesians 2:8-9). God says faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God (Romans 10:17). I am so incredibly thankful that someone shared the gospel with me, so that I was able to believe and be saved. My heart breaks for those who have not yet heard, or who have heard and not yet believed. That is why I try to talk about God and share my faith with others, even though it may be difficult and even though people may be offended. If we are afraid to share the gospel, God says we are to put our trust in Him (Psalm 56: 3). God also says we are to die to self and to choose to do what He commands (Luke 9:23-24, Galatians 2:20). One of God’s commands is to share the gospel (ie: Luke 14:23, Mark 16:15, Matthew 28:19-20: Jesus’ last words to His disciples). An example of a regular person sharing with others is the woman at the well. After meeting Jesus, she left her water jar and ran to the town to tell people about Him and many believed because of her testimony (John 4:29, 39). One of the greatest feelings in the world is sharing the gospel with others and seeing the Lord save them! The most loving and important thing we can ever share with others is the gospel. God called and saved us through the gospel (2 Thess 2:14), so let’s share that same gospel with others! For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes (Romans 1:16). May our faith be proclaimed around the world (Romans 1:8)!
