THE PASTOR'S MESSAGE BY REV. STEUART LINK

Dear TPC Family,

As Advent unfolds and we journey once more toward Bethlehem, I find myself recovering from a total shoulder replacement. It was not something that I planned for but as we all know, life happens, and we must take care of those things when they arise. As a result of my surgery, I am forced to slow down and reflect on how deeply we really need this season of holy waiting. The world around us rushes toward Christmas with lists, lights, and deadlines—but Advent invites us to pause, breathe, and listen for the still, small voice of God who comes not in power or noise, but in vulnerability and love.

Each week, as we light another candle on the Advent wreath—hope, peace, joy, and love—we proclaim that the Light still shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. These simple flames remind us of the truth we confess as Presbyterians: that God's grace breaks into the ordinary, transforming even the most ordinary places into holy ground.


