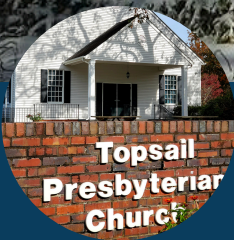

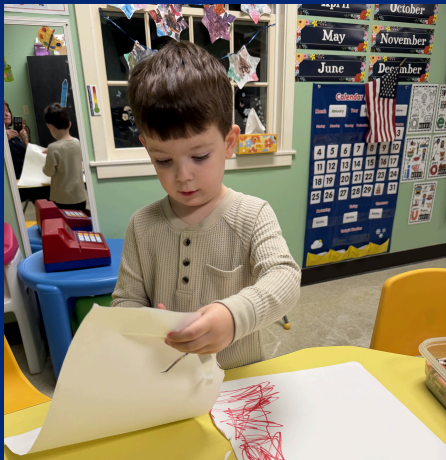

MORE YEARS OF RINGING AHEAD

Shortly after Easter, our handbells will be traveling to Pennsylvania to the Malmark factory for a complete refurbishment—a process that helps preserve the beauty and clarity of their sound for years to come. Our handbells were originally purchased in 1999 and last refurbished in 2014. Malmark recommends maintenance every 10–12 years. Malmark’s refurbishment process consists of 55 steps, but in general terms, it will include the following:

- Complete disassembly and inspection of each handbell, along with recommendations from the technicians
- Machine polishing of each casting, inside and out
- Cleaning, adjusting, and lubricating each clapper assembly
- Replacement of restraining springs and clapper heads as needed
- Free replacement of cracked handles and handguards for sets covered under Malmark’s Lifetime Warranty
- Reassembly and revoicing of each bell. After years of ringing, the metal naturally relaxes, and adjusting the strike point can reduce unwanted beats or vibrato, improving tonal quality
- Final hand polishing of each casting
- Inspection and cleaning of the cases

These bells have offered beauty, joy, and worshipful sound to our congregation for many years. With this careful maintenance, they will continue to enrich our services well into the future. We are grateful to the Session and the Finance Committee for supporting this important investment in the musical life of TPC. Their commitment helps ensure many more years of happy ringing.
