


Every aspect of our work involves volunteers for planning, leadership, preparation, and execution. Annually, it takes about 8,000 hours of volunteer time to sustain our ministries. Your gifts of time and talent truly make a difference in people's lives.

How to Volunteer

- Ask an Elder: The list of Elders is printed on the back page of our weekly worship bulletin. They can direct you to the right person or project.
- Online: Visit our church website. From the Home page, select "Contribute" on the top banner. This will take you to the Stewardship landing page. Scroll down to find two graphics—one for volunteering and one for donating. Select "Volunteer" to see a menu of opportunities. Choose the ones you are interested in and provide your contact information. Each option is linked to the Elder responsible for that ministry. Once you submit your form, the respective Elder will receive an email with your contact info and will follow up to help you get involved.

This chart represents the distribution of givers broken down by the amount given to the General Fund. For example: 9% of the households contributing to the General Fund (the budget) gave between \$150 and \$250 per month in 2024.

The Role of Donations in Our Church

Everything we do costs money for building, supplies, and services. Some donations are designated for specific purposes and cannot be used for operating expenses. Our sole source of funding is through donations from our congregation.

2025: Where We Are


The budget to meet the mission of the church is \$374,406. About 55% of that will come from pledged giving (commitment cards), and 45% from non-pledged/other giving. This ratio is consistent with our historical experience. Our volunteer elders and deacons aim to increase the percentage of pledged giving for the 2026 budget. Pledge or no pledge, we need your commitment to financially support our mission.

2026: Where We Need to Be

We are a dynamic and growing congregation with energetic leadership. We are searching for a new full-time pastor and expanding our children/youth ministry. Many new members are drawn to our vibrant children's programs and high-quality music program. Generous giving will allow us to continue improving and expanding these vital ministries.

We live in one of the fastest-growing communities in North Carolina. Our mission ministry is expanding as our community grows. The budget projection for 2026 is \$405,000, an 8% increase. Consider this information as you reflect on God's generosity and your response by supporting His ministry through our church.

Using the same group of givers as the previous chart, this chart represents the percentage fo the General Fund (the budget) supported by each group. For example: the total amount given by the households that contributed between \$150 and \$250 per month represented 8% of total contributions given to the General Fund in 2024.
