## Distribution

*As a member of the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS), Holy Communion is celebrated at Mt. *All are invited to the Lord's table. Those who share our confession of faith and who wish to commune are asked to extend their hands outward to receive the Sacrament. Others who have come forward will receive a blessing from the pastor. If you have any questions about this Communion statement, you are encouraged to speak with Pastor Koschmann. Thank you for respecting and honoring our Communion practice.*
