


Opportunity to Contribute

Our white storage shed in the parking lot has served us well over the years, but it is now time for a replacement. Originally constructed as a garage in the early 1940s, it has succumbed to rot and is beyond repair.

We believe that a smaller, premade Tuff Shed, measuring 10 X 12, will adequately meet our needs. The estimated cost for this shed is around \$5,000. By utilizing supplemental funds, such as Thrivent Choice and bazaar contributions, we can cover this expense. However, we are reaching out to the congregation for donations to help fund this project, ensuring that we do not deplete our other accounts. Please make note for any contributions as "Storage Shed Fund."

Donations can be placed in an envelope and included in the offering or mailed directly to the church.

We are excited to announce that the new shed is now up! Please take a moment to take a look on your way out of church today. It would be greatly appreciated in the fall to have volunteers to help us tear down the old shed. If we have enough volunteers, we could handle this task ourselves, eliminating the need to hire an external service.
