Women's Bible Study

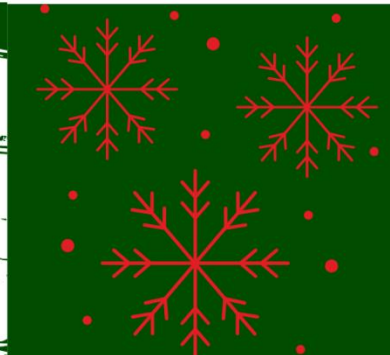
