Our Missions committee voted in January to help fund McLean Reagan on a mission trip to the Dominican Republic. Earlier this week, we received this response and we would like to share the blessing of his letter with the whole congregation.

Dear First Presbyterian,

Thank you for supporting me on my mission trip to the Dominican Republic over spring break. It would not have been possible without your support.

I partnered with Campus Crusade for Christ and Filter of Hope to spread the Gospel and install water filters in impoverished areas. 170 students were on the trip, with the majority being a part of Greek Life at Georgia Southern University. Five members of my fraternity, SAE, were on the trip in addition to myself. In total we gave out 576 water filters, spread the Gospel with 991 people, and 170 people prayed to receive Christ. It was incredible to see how God moved in those communities in the Dominican Republic and how faithful the believers were there even when they are confronted with poverty, lack of clean water and don't have access to food.

The Holy Spirit was also moving and working with those who went on the trip. We stayed in a town called Boni at a local Christian camp. Many of the cabins didn't have working plumbing, showers, or air conditioning, but it didn't matter. The amount of joy that I had from spreading the Gospel and feeling the Holy Spirit was astounding. Our late night worship sessions at the camp felt like Heaven on Earth. The coolest part of the whole experience was 22 people from our group gave their lives to Christ including two of my fraternity brothers.

I look forward to seeing how God continues to work in myself and others as we come back to Georgia Southern's campus. In the words of John Wesley, "If I had 300 men who fear nothing but God, hated nothing but sin, and were determined to know nothing among men but Jesus Christ and him crucified, I would set the world on fire."

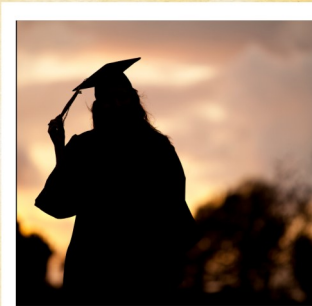

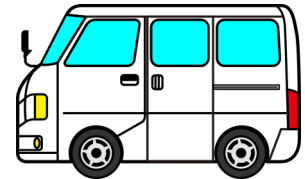
Cox Elementary School Ministry
