Confronted by Love

Lately, I've been preoccupied with one question: What is love? Scripture says,

"God is love" (1 John 4:8) and that the world will know we are Christ's disciples by our love (John 13:35). When we encounter real love, we are encountering the very presence of God. We glimpse Him in the tender gaze of a mother holding her newborn, or in the raw embrace of someone comforting a grieving friend.

To be confronted by love is to come face to face with God's heart. Love is more than a feeling—it's the deep desire for another's flourishing, and the commitment to help bring it about. Sometimes this means celebrating with someone in joy; other times, it means sitting with them in pain.

In church culture, saying "I love you" or even "God loves you" can easily become a cliché—a slogan of sentimentality without any real substance. Words don't mean much if we claim to love our neighbors but act in ways that devalue them. We do this when we refuse to empathize, when we gossip or label people as "other" without taking the time to understand their story. Those who don't fit neatly into our pre-made checklist of how people should be often become scapegoats for our prejudice.

It's easy to love those who are close to us—family, friends, our church community. But love becomes a challenge when it turns toward the stranger, the outsider, or even the person we see as an enemy. Different politics, religion, language, or culture can tempt us to withhold compassion.

Yet God's love for them is just as fierce and beautiful as it is for us. He sees their fears, wounds, and hopes. He died for them, too.

To be confronted by love means we don't get to choose who receives our compassion. We don't get to put limits on grace. We don't get to walk away when justice costs us something. It's choosing to see the image of God in every person—no exceptions, no loopholes.

So here's the question:

When love steps into your path, will you look away... or let it change you?


