Stewardship season is ending and the Session will have to adopt a 2026 budget at their meeting next week, Dec. 17. We wanted to update you on the campaign to date. We received 33 pledge cards totaling \$321,658. At present, the proposed 2026 budget is \$547,063. There is an obvious gap between our income and expenses for the coming year. If you intend to contribute in any way in 2026, we would greatly appreciate your returning your pledge card at your earliest convenience so we can make educated decisions moving forward on the future of the church. While the Church is in transition and there are many questions about our future, we have fixed expenses that must be paid to keep the church running. 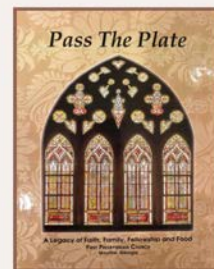

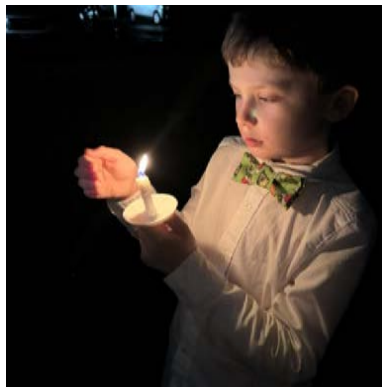
