We are excited to announce that our new FirstNaz Kids wing will begin opening on Sunday, September 6, 2020! We will begin by opening Children's Quizzing at 10:15. We will monitor how things go and from there possibly open the Kids Chapel, Preschool Church, and Sunday School in the future.

The safety of our children and volunteers is vitally important to us! Please read all the safety guidelines listed below. All children and volunteers are required to abide by these guidelines. We realize that not everyone is comfortable, and we understand if you prefer to continue on-line. We will continue to post on-line each week and will try to post Kids Chapel on Facebook Live when we start backup in-person. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.

AT HOME CHECKLIST:

- Daily temperature check – if your child has a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher, they should stay at home, watch on-line and not attend in person.
- If your child has any of the following symptoms, they should stay at home, watch on-line and not attend in person: sore throat or other signs of illness, like a cough, diarrhea, severe headache, vomiting, or body aches.
- If your child has had close contact to a COVID-19 case, they should stay at home, watch on-line and not attend in person.
- Review and practice proper hand washing techniques, especially before & after eating, sneezing, coughing, and adjusting a mask.
- Label your child's mask and face shield clearly in a permanent marker.
- Explain the importance of wearing a mask/face shield and how it protects them and other people from getting sick. A mask is required with a face shield.
- Talk with your child about the importance of social distancing.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURES:

- Use the restroom before leaving home OR before check-in (we want to limit our restroom trips)
- Children and volunteers must wear a mask, a face shield may be worn over a mask
- Clean hands before entering kids wing
- Touchless Temperature/wellness check at Check-in
- Only volunteers and children will be permitted past check-in
- We ask that the same person drop off and pick-up child(ren)

KIDS' CHAPEL/CLASSROOM SAFETY PROCEDURES:

- Regularly monitor volunteers/children for symptoms
- Limit class sizes (for social distancing)
- Everyone wear a mask, a face shield may be worn over a mask
- Hand sanitizer will be available and encouraged often
- Social distancing (six-foot distances when possible)
- No games requiring close physical contact
- No shared drinks or food. Bottled water and prepackaged food on special occasions
- No sharing of materials
- Rooms will be sanitized between each use
- No use of drinking fountains
