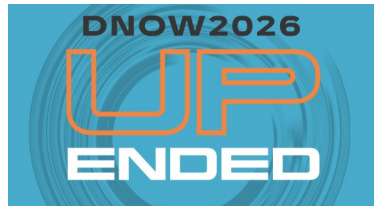
Tea Party
