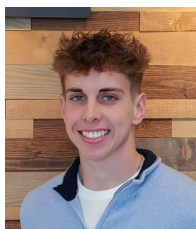

Baptism

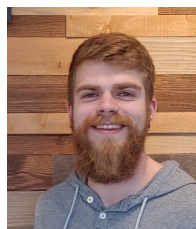

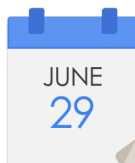

The Value of the Resurrection

1 Corinthians 15:12-23



Main Idea: Christians must rejoice over the radiance of Christ and the power of the resurrection from the dead.

The Argument: If the resurrection is not real the ramifications are ruinous, but if the resurrection is real the ramifications reveal the radiance of the Son and the power of the resurrection.

Ruinous Results if the Resurrection is not Real: (1 Corinthians 15:12-19)

Radiant Results of a Real Resurrection: (1 Corinthians 15:20-23)

Conclusion: (1 Corinthians 15:24-28; 50-58)
