Tonight from 7-8pm, gather for prayer in the Conference Center. The evening will begin with corporate prayer and then we will break out into smaller groups. All are invited!



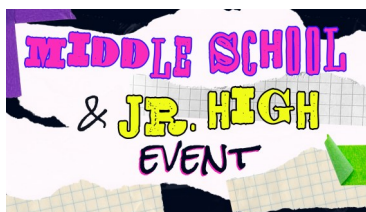
Future Vision
