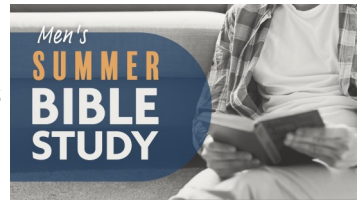
Moving On Up & Lunch

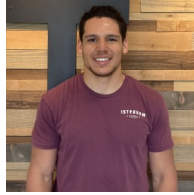

Baptisms & New Members

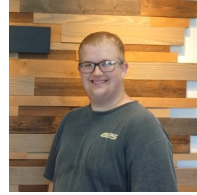

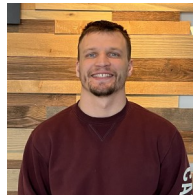
