


On mission to make and multiply disciples of Christ in our neighborhoods, among the nations, and of the next generation.



Small Groups

Supper Clubs allow us to get to know each other better and share the fellowship of a simple meal. They are great for both regulars and newcomers to build relationships outside Sunday mornings.


