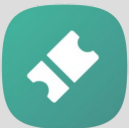


Ladies' Retreat

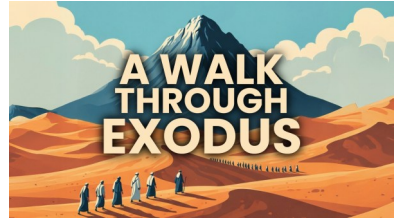

Small Groups

Supper Clubs allow us to get to know each other better and share the fellowship of a simple meal. They are great for both regulars and newcomers to build relationships outside Sunday mornings.

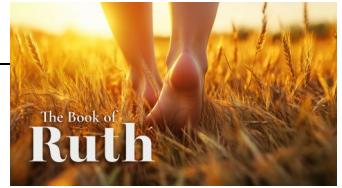
