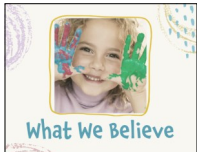

## Fall Christian Growth Seminar

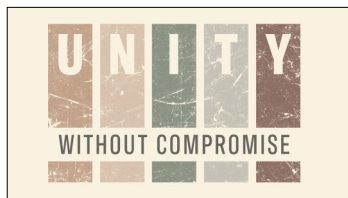

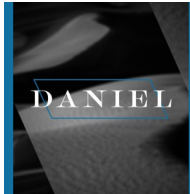
## The Book of James

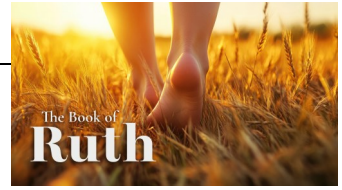
