



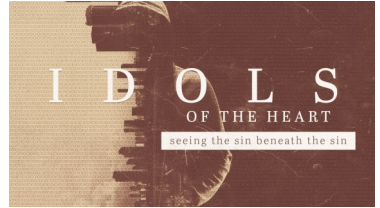

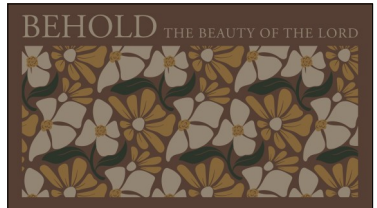
Supper Clubs

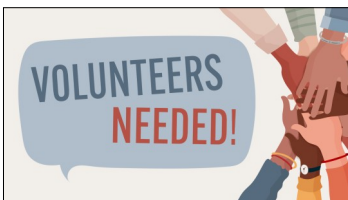

Small Groups

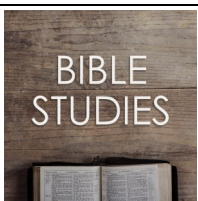
Small Groups **start this week!** Please sign up today so our leaders can be prepared to welcome you!

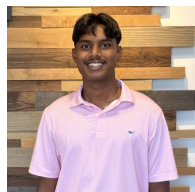


GOD at WORK
