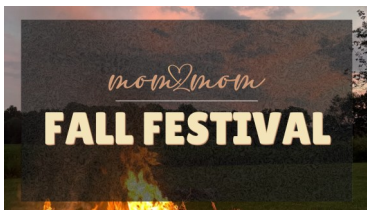
Starting Point

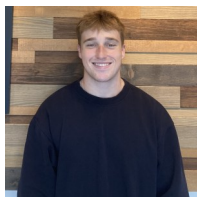

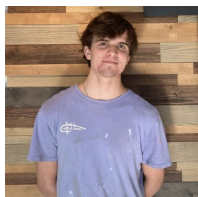
Baptisms

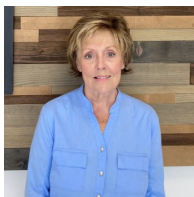
If you desire to be baptized, please complete a Baptism Packet, which can be found in the lobby or online, and we will set up a time to meet with an elder.

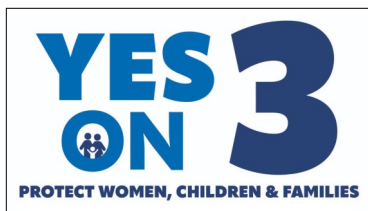

Amendment 3

As Christians, we are called to defend, protect, and value all human life. To that end we want to inform our church body of an important proposed pro-life and pro-family amendment to the Missouri State Constitution that will be on the ballot on November 3rd. Among other things, Amendment 3 aims to:

- Restore the protection of the life of the unborn
- Ban transgender surgeries for minors
- Restore parental rights related to their children's reproductive healthcare
