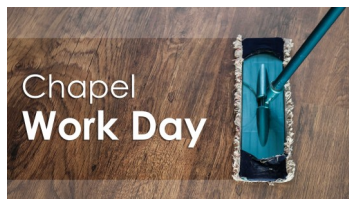

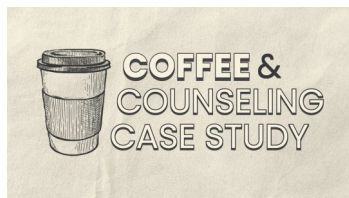
Pray for Me
