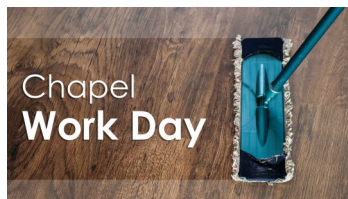

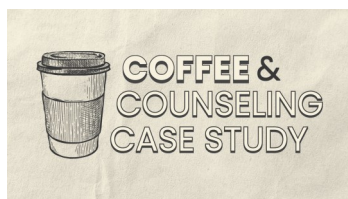
Pray for Me

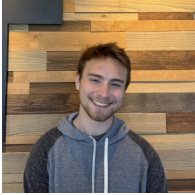

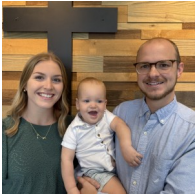
