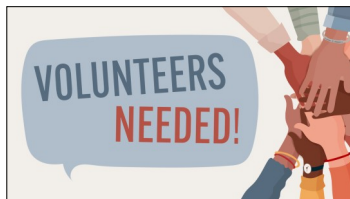

MINISTRY NEEDS

We praise God for a growing and vibrant church body. As we grow, so do the opportunities to serve one another as we do life together. We have several current needs to enable ministries to continue and thrive. Please prayerfully consider how you can serve the Lord here at The Chapel. Contact the office to get involved.



- Some of our members are unable to consistently join the body for corporate worship and events. The **Agape Ministry Team** helps ensure our church maintains regular and ongoing care for these members. Visits, calls, and cards of encouragement help us stay connected with one another.
- The **Event Coordinator** helps bring our church family together by planning select events from the approved calendar and guiding teams of volunteers to prepare and serve through church-wide gatherings. Events include our Annual Dinner & Meeting, Party in the Park, and holiday services (Easter, Thanksgiving, & Christmas).
- The **Funeral Coordinator** works closely with our elders and pastors to prepare for and carry out a funeral service for a Chapel member. They communicate with family members to plan the various elements of the service, arrange for building access, serve as a point of contact with funeral home representatives and florists, and help with logistics the day of the service.
- Our **Grounds Crew Volunteers** help to keep the outer face of our facility tidy and welcoming. They work together to oversee exterior needs like landscaping, weed control, and maintaining fences, railings, and playground equipment.
