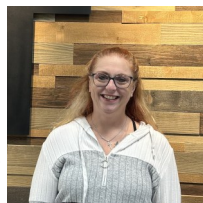

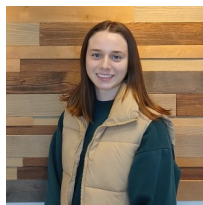
GOD at WORK
