As Cape Bible Chapel members, we will seek to play an active role in this local body of Christ.

Having been brought by divine grace to repent and believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and to give up ourselves to Him, relying on His power and direction, we joyfully commit ourselves to each other.

We will work and pray for the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

We will walk together in brotherly love, exercise loving care and watchfulness over each other and faithfully admonish one another as occasion may require.

We will not forsake the assembling of ourselves together, nor neglect to pray for ourselves and others.

We will seek to bring up those children within our families and others who may at any time be under our care in the nurture and admonition of the Lord, and by a pure and loving example seek the salvation of our family, friends and others.

We will rejoice at each other's happiness and strive with tenderness and sympathy to bear each other's burdens and sorrows.

We will seek, by God's power and direction, to live carefully in the world, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts. Remembering that we have been redeemed at the cross and are new creations in Christ, we therefore have a special obligation to bear the fruit of our salvation and lead a new and holy life.

We will work together for the continuance of a faithful evangelical ministry in this church, as we sustain its worship, ordinances, discipline, doctrines, and ministries as supported by the church leadership.

We will seek to worship God both joyfully and in a God-centered, not man-centered, manner.

We will contribute cheerfully and regularly to the support of the ministry, the expenses of the church, the relief of the needy, and the spread of the Gospel to all nations.

We will submit to the leadership of the elders for biblical shepherding and oversight of this local body of Christ. This shepherding includes teaching, prayer, encouragement, burden sharing, admonishment, and church discipline as the occasion may require.

We will, if we move from this place, as soon as possible, unite with some other Christ-centered, Bible believing church where we can worship and serve Him according to the principles of His Word.

May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us all.
