Program Aspects

We are a full time program, open Monday - Friday from 6:30 a.m. until 5:30 p.m. CFLC cares for children 6 weeks through Pre-K.

Infants are provided with a warm, nurturing, and stimulating environment that promotes optimal development. Infant teachers follow a lesson plan of daily activities that promote social, emotional, cognitive, and physical development.

Daily activities include dramatic play, books, fine motor, music, yoga, as well as language development with the use of sign language in the classroom.

Toddler and pre-k classes follow a weekly themed lesson plan. Lesson plans include daily activities that relate to each week's theme. Daily activities may include blocks, dramatic play, fine motor, books, arts and crafts, science, math, and writing.

Three and four year old classes include a weekly Bible verse with their lesson plan. These children also attend weekly chapel where they will hear children's Bible stories, sing Christian children's songs, and recite their weekly Bible verse. These classes use the *Between the Lions* early literacy program and *High Scope Math* in the curriculum. The Pre-K class includes a foundational phonics program in the daily activities. All lesson plans and assessments use the MS Early Learning Guidelines and Standards for their age group.
